Activity

A radio broadcast of The Little Fish that discovered the Sea

Story: The Little Fish that discovered the Sea | **Method:** (voice) Drama

Age group: 8-10 years

| **Groups of:** whole class + 4 children

Duration:

| **Preparation time:** 2 hours

Central topic:

- Discovering the radio broadcast as a means of storytelling

Material required:

- Audio recorders/mobile phones
- Computer with Internet access

The aims of this activity are:

- Observing, describing and organizing reality
- Experimenting with reading text aloud

Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Convert written text and stories into drama scripts
- Retell a story through role play and drama
- Write drama scripts from narrative texts



Step by step approach:

1. Children listen to a radio broadcast and react to it.
2. Children listen to the story read aloud and simulate the radio broadcasting studio: they create the roles, develop scripts from the story and experiment with broadcasters' voices and select background sounds.
3. Children rehearse the broadcasted scripts of the story, the sounds they have selected for backgrounds and record themselves.
4. Assessment: Children discuss three main areas, which are speakers' quality; if the story was retold as a whole and a combination of broadcasting elements such as text quality, background, etc.
