How the game of the clouds could make a rivulet

Story: The Rivulet

| **Method:** Dramatised story

Age group: 7-12 years

| **Groups of:** 20 children

Duration: 25 min

| **Preparation time:** 2 weeks

Central topic:

- Dramatization of the story “*The Rivulet*” with a cast of children
- Creating a richer image concept of the Earth’s water resources and the cycle of the life in nature

Material required:

- Costumes
- Stage props

The aims of this activity are:

- Get familiar to the type of Drama Theatre and the basic terms in the theatre art
- Have equal access to the art in an informal, friendly environment
- Upgrade the knowledge of the water cycle and the significance of water
- Develop fantasy and interpretation skills
- Express the messages of the dramaturgical text
- Develop skills for active communication – between actors and audience, in the conditions of Drama Theatre

Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Discovery and encouragement of the artistic talents of the children by the means of theatre art
- Building an actor-spectator relation in the theatre performance and transforming it into the means for development of narrative skills
- Possibility for interpretation of the text, enriching the verbal expression and drawing a message

Step by step approach:

1. Making a script based on the story
2. Distribution of the roles
3. Design and production of costumes and props
4. Musical solutions and stage lighting
5. Drama Theatre performance
6. Sharing insights and impressions
