### Activity

# How the legend could come true

**Story:** The family tale of the Shtarkovs

| **Method:** Kamishibai

**Age group:** 7-12 years

| **Groups of:** up to 15 children

**Duration:** 25 min.

| **Preparation time:** 1, 5 weeks

Central topic:

- Development of narrative skills through the method of Kamishibai Theatre based on “*The Family tale of the Shtarkovs*”
- Drawing the symbolic meaning of the water in the context of the folkloric plot

Material required:

- Kamishibai box
- Illustrated cards or paintings based on the story
- Painting materials

The aims of this activity are:

- Learn the historical legend
- Explore other legends related to the symbolic meaning of the water
- Create, express themselves and their attitude to the history science
- Fantasize and co-experience the events
- Immerse actively in the artistic recreation of the legend
- Develop skills for an active communication



## Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Discovery and encouragement of children's artistic talents by the means of theatre and fine arts
- Stimulating the development of imagination
- Upgrading folklore and local history terms and knowledge
- Possibility for presentation in a library, school or even in the open air

## Step by step approach:

1. Identification of the presentation venue – a library, a kindergarten, an educational centre
2. Supply of a wooden box for Kamishibai Theatre
3. Production of paintings based on the story
4. Musical background
5. Presentation of the story through Kamishibai Theatre
