Activity

How the legend could come true

Story: The family tale of the Shtarkovs | **Method:** Dramatised story

Age group: 7-12 years | **Groups of:** up to 20 children

Duration: 30 min | **Preparation time:** 2 weeks

Central topic:

- Drama Theatre performance based on “*The Family Tale of the Shtarkovs*” with the participation of children as actors
- Drawing the symbolic meaning of water in the context of a folkloric plot

Material required:

- Costumes
- Stage props

The aims of this activity are:

- Develop children’s imagination by the means of Drama Theater
- Immerse actively in the artistic recreation of the folkloric tale
- Develop skills for an active communication in the process of creating and presenting the spectacle
- Read and establish the cause-and-effect relationships in the narration

Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Discovery and encouragement of children's artistic talents by the means of the theatre art
- Development of the imagination and narrative skills as well as drawing messages

Step by step approach:

1. Making a script based on the story
2. Distribution of the roles
3. Design and production of costumes and props
4. Musical solutions and stage lighting
5. Drama Theatre performance
6. Sharing insights and impressions
