# Motives and emotions of story characters through teamwork

**Story:** The life giving water

| **Method:** Dramatized story

**Age group:** 9-10 years

| **Groups of:** max. 16 students

**Duration:** 80 minutes

| **Preparation time:**

Central topic:

- The life-giving water

Material required:

- Fairytale: The life giving water
- 6 cardboard, colored, pencils, pastels, paints

The aims of this activity are:

- develop teamwork
- use their imagination for the purposes of the activities
- create their own figures

Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Identify and analyze the motives of an imaginary or real person for traveling

### Step by step approach:

1. The teacher reads the rest of the story to the students and asks them, as they are in their groups, to prepare a theatrical stage for the adventure of each brother. At present they show their theatres to the other children.
2. Students work in teams and make the figure of each brother (a figure for each team) in a large cardboard and then they add on the paper, either in words or with drawings, key facts, motives and emotions of that character. Then, each group presents its own character by placing the figures in the table.
3. The teacher asks the students to prepare a cover for the story in their groups and give a different title. Then present them in the class.
