Narrating folktales and texts through an imaginative journey

Story: The Rivulet

| **Method:** Dramatised story

Age group: 8-9 years

| **Groups of:** max. 16 students

Duration:

| **Preparation time:** 2 hours

Central topic:

- A rivulet

Material required:

- Fairy Tale: The rivulet (Bulgaria)
- Large cardboard, pastels, colored pencils
- Soft ball

The aims of this activity are:

- developing teamwork
- painting the friends of the rivulet
- creating a three-dimensional image using their bodies
- telling the story in their own words
- writing dialogues between the rivulet and its friends





Narrative competencies to be developed:

- Demonstrate positive stances towards listening, reading and narrating folktales and other narrative texts, viewing the act of storytelling as an imaginative journey, but also as a way of interpreting real life.
- Apply narrative strategies to present convincingly, ideas and arguments, relating stories

Step by step approach:

1. Teacher mentions the title of the story "The rivulet", reads it and invites the students to tell the story.
2. Teacher divides the students into two groups and invites students to take roles as friends of the rivulet and paint themselves, writing short dialogues.
3. Teacher asks the two groups to use their bodies to create a three-dimensional image, freezing a moment, and then describe the image they see.
