The Rivulet - teaching narration through dramatised story

Story: The Rivulet

| **Method:** Dramatised story

Age group: 10-14 years

| **Groups of:** 25 children

Duration: 90 minutes

| **Preparation time:** 60 minutes

Central topic:

- Narration of the legend based on dramatising the story
- Making students act the roles of protagonists

Material required:

- Pieces of paper with suggestions for the role plays

The aims of this activity are:

- Developing narrative skills using the method of dramatising
- Making students act the roles of protagonists
- Making students discuss the value of feelings
- Giving own ideas and developing the plot
- Making dialogs

Step by step approach:

1. Teacher gives the title of the legend and asks what can be the plot.
2. Teacher tells the whole story making students guess the steps.
3. Teacher asks the students to choose the role of the protagonists.

| 4. Chosen students stay in front of the class and play their roles, the teacher supports them and shows how to do it. |
| 5. Students work in pairs and write the further adventures of the Rivulet. |
| 6. Students discuss their ideas and choose the best ones. |
| 7. Homework: students prepare in groups the dramatised story of the further adventures of the protagonist. |
