Activity

The importance of water

Story: Life giving water

| **Method:** Kamishibai

Age group: 10-16 years

| **Groups of:** 25 children

Duration: 45 minutes

| **Preparation time:** 90 minutes

Central topic:

- Developing narrative skills using kamishibai cards
- Making students discuss the generation gap and relationship between father and daughter
- Making students discuss the problem of the lack of sweet water
- Developing students' knowledge about Portuguese legend

Material required:

- Stripes with dialogs of the protagonists
- Pieces of paper and colourful pencils

The aims of this activity are:

- Developing narrative skills using kamishibai cards
- Making students discuss the need of help older, sick and weaker members of the family
- Making students discuss how to behave to achieve the aims
- Listening carefully to the story
- Giving own ideas and developing the plot
- Making dialogs

Step by step approach:

1. Teacher gives the stripes with short dialogs of the protagonists and asks students to work in pairs and put them in the correct order
2. Teacher asks chosen students to read the dialogs one after another and discusses with the whole groups the order of the dialogs
3. Teacher asks every pair of students to draw the kamishibai card, connected with one dialog
4. Chosen student shows all the cards one after another and the students repeat the dialogs in a correct order
5. Students discuss in groups such a question: What would happen, if the protagonist behave in another way They give their ideas, how would the plot change
6. Students discuss the topic, what is the value of water in today life
7. Homework: students are expected to look for another stories about water and tell them in front of the class
